The Dog Training Club of Champaign-Urbana, 2210 West Ford Harris Road, Urbana, IL 61802 is located ¼ mile East of the Ford Harris Road and Route 45 (approx. 3 miles N. of I 74)
(we meet in ring 1 on the North end near the kitchen)

The dates are: July 10, 17, 24, 31, Aug 7, and 14.

7:00pm - Conformation Handling – Ring Procedure and Practice: Open to all handlers with prior experience. This class will cover general presentation of the show dog including stacking, gaiting and ring procedures, along with practice and perfecting of ring skills.

There will be paperwork to fill out and a list of rules for use of this facility will be handed out to each new participant.

If you are new to our class or have not been for a while, please bring an **updated copy** of your dog's **vaccination record** including proof of rabies with you **to be kept in our files.**

Dress comfortably with good "running" shoes. You may want to bring water for your dog also

Due to Kennel Cough and K9 influenza viruses circulating, we request that if you suspect your dog may have symptoms or has come in contact with the virus that you keep your dogs at home and contact your veterinarian about further treatment. Those with healthy dogs that come to class, please keep them under control, not allowing close contact with others. We also advise you bring your own water dish for your dog should they need a drink.

Legislative and Outreach Report

Illinois 2018 AKC All Events Data

In 2018 there were 838 AKC licensed and sanctioned events held in Illinois in which more than 106,800 dogs participated. Over the last four years there was an increase in the number of events held in Illinois with a modest increase in the number of participants.

2017: 779 events with 104,900 dog participants
2016: 772 events with 108,800 dog participants
2015: 683 events with 100,100 dog participants.

Below is a discussion of the Economic Impact of AKC Dog Events in Illinois.

From the desk of the American Kennel Club:

Economic Impact of AKC Dog Events in Illinois

The American Kennel Club (AKC) was established in 1884 to promote the study, breeding, exhibiting, and advancement of purebred dogs. We now represent more than 5,000 dog clubs nationally, including **178** clubs in the state of Illinois.

The AKC sanctions thousands of dog events each year, which generate significant economic benefits to local communities in addition to the millions of dollars AKC dog owners in Illinois spend annually on their dogs.

Here are the statistics for the State of Illinois over the past three years:

2016: AKC licensed and sanctioned 722 events in the state of Illinois, in which more than 108,800 dogs participated.

2017: AKC licensed and sanctioned 779 events in the state of Illinois, in which more than 104,900 dogs participated.

2018: AKC licensed and sanctioned 838 events in the state of Illinois, in which more than 106,800 dogs participated.

The AKC conducts ongoing research regarding the economic impact of AKC events in localities throughout the state, as well as of AKC registered dogs in the state. Surveys demonstrate that exhibitors at AKC conformation dog shows spend an average of \$685 per show weekend. This means spending by AKC dog show exhibitors for a show weekend could inject more than \$1.7 million into the local economy. And because AKC dog shows are an educational and family-friendly event, large spectator gates can generate additional revenues for cities and towns statewide.
