Winter Conformation Classes

Held in the DTCCU Climate Controlled Training Building (we meet in ring 1 on the North end near the kitchen)

The CIKC began the New Year with **Conformation "Warm-Up" Classes.** This class will be ring practice for those who want to work their dogs in a show ring setting.

We request that you **please email and sign up** if you plan to attend, so we know how many to expect.

The 6-week session will run Wed Jan 15th, 22nd, 29th, (Feb 5th cancelled), 12th, and 19th.

Classes are held at **7:00pm** and depending on attendance, will run 45 minutes to an hour or more.

General Public- \$55.00 per handler for 6 wk. session. Club Members- \$40.00 per handler for 6 wk. session. Drop-in Fee - \$10.00 per handler

(Make checks out to CIKC)

There will be an info card to fill out the first night and a list of rules for use of this facility will be handed out to each new participant.

If you are a **beginner** who wishes to sign up to learn how to handle their dog in a conformation ring, please **send your request** along with your name, email, and info on your breed. The fee for a beginner is \$55.00 for the 6-week session, **no refund except under specific situations**.

Please Remember:

*All participants and their guests are expected to follow the guidelines set forth by both clubs at all times while on the grounds. Please pick up your copy of the rules at the ringside table when filling out your class card.

*It is required that all participants pick up after their dogs. Use only the areas marked for this purpose. Equipment is available on the grounds along with a proper <u>outside</u> disposal area. If clean up is needed inside the building, please <u>dispose</u> of all solid waste outside in the disposal area.

*Remember that humane treatment of your dogs is imperative at all times, but especially while on club grounds.

*Bitches in season are not allowed to participate. Please contact the class coordinator if you are unable to attend due to your female coming in season. Beginning handlers are encouraged to come and watch.

*Also remember that Handicapped Parking areas are only for those with the correct parking passes properly displayed.

During the next four months it is likely that multiple bills will again emerge that contain provisions which are problematic for responsible dog owners, people who compete in performance sports and event trials, and small breeders.
