Held in the DTCCU Climate Controlled Training Building (we meet in ring 1 on the North end near the kitchen)

The Winter Conformation handling classes ended March 4. We will be starting a new Spring Session April 1st.

PLEASE NOTE THE 4-H CLASSES WILL BE STARTING THE SAME NIGHT, SO PLEASE KEEP YOUR DOGS UNDER CONTROL AND RESPECT THE NEW YOUNG TRAINERS.

We request that you **please email and sign up** if you plan to attend, so we know how many to expect.

The 6-week session will run Wed April 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th, and May 6th.

Class will start at **7:00pm**General Public- \$55.00 per handler for 6 wk. session.
Club Members- \$40.00 per handler for 6 wk. session.
Drop-in Fee - \$10.00 per handler

There will be an info card to fill out the first night and a list of rules for use of this facility will be handed out to each new participant.

If you are a **beginner** who wishes to sign up to learn how to handle your dog in a conformation ring, please **send your request** along with your name, email, and info on breed and age of your dog. The fee for a beginner is \$55.00 for the 6-week session, **no refund except under specific situations**.

Please Note- Understand that weather changes in a moment's notice. Use your discretion if weather is a question. Please Remember:

*All participants and their guests are expected to follow the guidelines set forth by both clubs at all times while on the grounds. Please pick up your copy of the rules at the ringside table when filling out your class card.

*It is required that all participants pick up after their dogs. Use only the areas marked for this purpose. Equipment is available on the grounds along with a proper <u>outside</u> disposal area. If clean up is needed inside the building, please <u>dispose</u> of all solid waste outside in the disposal area.

- *Remember that humane treatment of your dogs is imperative at all times, but especially while on club grounds.
- *Bitches in season are not allowed to participate. Please contact the class coordinator if you are unable to attend due to your female coming in season. Beginning handlers are encouraged to come and watch.
